### **Resident Energy Challenge**

The Residence Challenge is a competition between all the residential colleges at UWA to see which residence can reduce the most unnecessary electricity and water use. The residence challenge is also a platform to provide students living in residence a voice and to empower them to make significant change for a more sustainable future. We are looking at starting the program on Saturday March 28th 2009 and using Earth Hour as a platform for the program to start. The program has been previously been held all over Canada & the United States and has been incredibly successful.

The main aims of the program is as follows:

- to educate college residents on current social and environmental issues
- to work for positive action in the fight against climate change
- to reduce green house emissions and global footprint and towards a more sustainable community
- to organize events for college residents in order to create positive change in combating some of the social justice issues that face us today
- to promote IC events so that residents can participate fully in the communities of which they are a part of.
- to generate financial aid and other forms of support for like-minded agencies and causes in our university and local communities (there are several grants available through the government up to the value of \$20,000 which are worth applying for)
- Forming a website dedicated to the IC commitment to help the environment like that of the Canadian Universities
- getting outside parties in to promote or create awareness of what we are achieving (i.e channel 10, newspapers etc)
